




Conor Bowens ranked 1st in Thailand across 8 subjects, including Top in English Literature; Berta Palop Roca earned the highest mark in Asia for GCSE Art & Design; and Yichen Ma (Daniel) was recognized as Top in the World for IGCSE Mathematics.

In the 2023-24 AS and A Level exams, 32% of HeadStart students achieved A* or A grades. Notable achievers included Head Boy, Krit (Krittat Phaisamran), and Selly (Hyunji Lee), who received High Achievement Awards in AS English Literature and A Level Chemistry, respectively. Kirill Kochetkov was ranked Top in Thailand in A Level Mathematics.

These accomplishments reflect not only individual student talent but also the effectiveness of HeadStart's comprehensive curriculum. which emphasizes critical thinking, creativity, and global citizenship. The school's tailored approach to education ensures that each student receives the support they need to thrive academically. Reflecting on her successful journey, Berta, who achieved the Highest Mark in Asia for GCSE Art & Design, explained that much of her drive comes from within. "It's more like a pressure I put on myself," she a pressure I put on myself," she shared, emphasising that she didn't feel external pressure from her parents to excel. "My parents have never forced me to get good grades. It's just something I thought might be possible, so why not?" Berta credits her teachers for providing invaluable guidance, particularly

in art, where understanding the deeper meaning of her work was a key focus. "What I think most people miss is the deeper meaning behind your work," she explained. This thoughtful approach was something her teachers encouraged, helping her focus on the aspects that examiners look for when grading coursework.

Krit, our Head Boy, credits his High Achievement in English Literature to the supportive environment at HeadStart, where small class sizes encourage discussion and critical thinking. "The process of thinking, analysing, breaking down texts, and linking ideas is the most important thing," Krit explained, highlighting the importance of highlighting the importance of discourse in refining his ideas. He also noted that his teachers challenge students' opinions, fostering a learning environment where both students and teachers are open to changing their
